The Wisconsin DPI recently released School Report Card scores for public schools in the state. Washington-Caldwell's School Report Card score was an 83.0 or "Significantly Exceeds Expectations." How did we accomplish this improvement?

We are more focused on what we are doing during school each day. We are more intentional in how we schedule academic teaching time. Using M.A.P. testing gives us additional data as to where our students are presently achieving and how we can assist students in improving performance.

We are also engaging students more by specifically doing a better job explaining the importance of standardized tests. Whether we like it or not, standardized testing is a part of our lives. Some examples are, Forward Testing, PALS, AIMSweb, PSAT, SAT, ACT, etc. Feel free to call me if you need an explanation as to what this alphabet soup means.). This effort is year-round and not just at standardized testing time. Parent involvement is extremely important, too!

This "School Report Card" is part of an accountability system that Wisconsin has established. The purpose of the "School Report Card" is to give additional information as to how public schools in Wisconsin are doing in their efforts to help students grow.
